

# Manners for Taking out Recyclables and Garbage

Put your recyclables or garbage into the specified bags and take them to the designated collection station by 8:30 AM on their respective collection days.



Garbage that fits into designated bags for household garbage, other than recyclables and oversized garbage

## Kitchen garbage

- Food garbage Drain off the water.
- Cooking oil Solidify or soak up the oil with paper.



# Rechargeable batteries and electronic cigarettes

Please throw them into the nearest collection box as it may cause ignition.



### Ceramics, glass, blades, needles, etc.

Wrap them with appropriate paper, such as newspaper, Break bamboo skewers in two.



### Spray cans, gas cans, and lighters


To prevent the risk of explosion and fire, make sure you use up the contents and do not puncture the items before putting them out.





# **《Recyclables》 Plastic**

Items made entirely of plastic and small enough to fit within the dimensions of a specified bag (Standard: less than 50 cm in length per side)

Never put batteries or fuels as they may cause incidents, such as ignition.

Food containers. such as egg cartons. tofu packages, bento containers, and pudding containers

## Note: Items made of silicone should be disposed of as household garbage.

Be sure to remove the cap of any item marked with an asterisk (\*). Otherwise, the item cannot be crushed easily.

# Attention! Do not put in the following items!

Items containing materials other than plastic Items that are larger than 50 cm on a side and cannot fit in the designated bag







### Home care waste

Dialysis bags, intravenous (IV) bags, tubes, catheters, and syringes used at home (contact a hospital for what to do with items that have needles, blook, or other body fluids on them).
